

Armco Credit Union Scholarship Guidelines

The following guidelines will apply to the application and awarding of \$20,000 in scholarships to students bound for full-time enrollment at an accredited college/university or trade school where additional expenses are accrued in Fall 2026. Twenty students will be awarded \$1,000 each. Scholarships are independently scored and ranked.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Must have been an Armco Credit Union member, or have a parent or legal guardian who is a member, since December 31, 2025.
- 2. Be a member in good standing
- 3. Have a GPA of at least 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale)
- 4. Be an incoming college freshman student of the upcoming 2026-2027 class.

Application Requirements

- 1. Complete an Armco Credit Union Scholarship Application
- 2. Provide a school transcript through the Fall 2025 semester which must accompany application and resume. Official transcripts are not necessary.
- 3. Provide a current resume containing the following categories along with dates. *Only jobs/activities during your junior and senior years will be judged.*
 - Jobs held
 - Volunteer activities
 - Extracurricular activities

Selection Criteria

Scholarship recipients will be chosen by a committee comprised of credit union members. All decisions concerning the scholarship award will be the responsibility of the Scholarship Committee. All decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final. The scholarship recipients will demonstrate a balanced combination of:

- 1. Academic achievement
- 2. Strong work ethic (part-time work and/or volunteerism)
- 3. School and community activities
- 4. Extra points awarded for students who have an Armco Credit Union account

Timelines

- 1. Armco Credit Union Scholarship Applications will be available at ArmcoCU.com.
- 2. Completed application packets may be emailed, mailed or dropped off at any branch (before close of business) by **Friday, Feb. 27, 2026**. Late or incomplete packages will not be considered.
- 3. Scholarship recipients will be announced in May 2026. Students will be notified via the email address they provide and should check their email regularly.
- 4. Award checks will be made payable to both the recipient and the school, and mailed to the school prior to the start of the fall semester and applied to their school account after the drop/add period.
